

# **MEETING 13**

**WERE YOU OUT LAST NIGHT?**

***Read this dialogue!***

Spike : That's was brilliant! You were really good, Chilli.

Chilli : Thanks. It wasn't bad. We've got a new bass guitarist

Spike : Would you like a drink?

Chilli : Yes, please

Spike : What would you like? A coke?

Chilli : No, thanks. I'd like a glass of mineral water

Spike : With ice and lemon?

Chilli : yes, Please

Another situation

Emily : Was Daniel out with Spike last night?

Luke : I don't know. Go and ask him!

Emily : Daniel, can I ask you something?

Daniel : sure

Emily : Were you in town with Spike last night?

Daniel : yes, I was. Why?

Emily : Do you like her?

Daniel : yes, of course I do

Emily : I see

Daniel : Would you like a drink?

Emily : No, Thank you

Another situation

Spike : Hey Emily! What 's the matter?

Emily : Nothing! Go away and leave me alone!

### ***Useful phrases***

That was brilliant

Can I ask you something?

Nothing!

Go away!

Leave me alone!

### ***Offering, accepting and refusing***

Would you like a drink?

Yes, please / No, thanks

What would you like?

I'd (I would) like a mineral water, please

With ice and lemon?

Yes, please / No, Thanks. Just ice
